THIS WEEK'S LESSON: ON YOUR KNEES, DUDE



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Jesus said the poor in spirit, the humble, will receive the kingdom of heaven. David was humble and submitted to King Saul as Israel's leader. 1 Samuel 24:1-7



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Play a game of Uno with the kids. Uno is a game about losing, about getting rid of all your cards instead of trying to end up with the most. What can Uno teach us about being humble?



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why didn't David kill Saul when he had the chance?
- Why is being humble important to God?
- What did Jesus promise to people who are humble and poor in spirit?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:32 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:
