THIS WEEK'S LESSON: NICE HEART, DUDE

IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: Jesus said the pure in heart will see God. God wants us to flee from sin and keep our hearts and minds as free of evil as possible. Proverbs 4:10-19

TANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse: "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:32 (NIV)



MPARENT TIME:
